

# THE GRANDE RONDE COWBOY ACTION FUN SHOOT

This is designed to be a really different shoot folks with no frills, minimal entry fee and limited awards. The purpose is to have fun while shooting cowboy action.

Co-directors: Road Agent (Tim Mahan, La Grande), Brownie Nash (Jim Crittenden, Burns) and Biscuits Bill (Bill Boren, La Grande). Now you know with this combination it has to be fun.

Dates: June 20, 21 & 22, 2008 (3<sup>rd</sup> weekend of June).

Friday, pot or fun shoots starting at 1 pm and registration at the Clubhouse from 4 pm –7 pm.

Saturday: 8 am registration, 9 am mandatory safety meeting with Pledge of Allegiance and then let's shoot.

Sunday, no safety meeting, so shoot will start at 8:30 am. As soon as possible after the shoot, the awards will be presented.

Entry fee: \$20 for adults and \$15 for Juniors pays for Saturday and Sunday. No packets will be handed out. E-mail or letter confirmation of entries will be sent asap after entry is received. This will be a posse-against-posse shoot and posse assignments and stage descriptions will be posted at the Clubhouse. Dry camping is available at the range free of charge.

SASS rules apply but SASS membership NOT required.

Stages: Six on Saturday and six on Sunday.

Awards: A medallion will be awarded to the top man, top woman, and top junior boy and girl. Category ribbon awards will be presented those placing 1<sup>st</sup> through 3<sup>rd</sup> in each category, including buckaroo shoot.

**Fun or Pot shoots** – depends on what the shooters want.

(1) Long-range single shot rifle on Friday, June 20 starting at 1 pm. Distance will be 300 yards. Location: 300 yd. range. If a pot shoot, the cost is \$1 per person per relay. Winner of overall pot shoot gets the pot with the winner announced at the Awards Ceremony.

(2) Lever action big bore shoot on will be held on Friday, June 20 starting at 1 pm. Location: 300 yd. range. The lever rifle will be shot 200-250 yards using cross sticks. If a pot shoot, cost is \$1 per person per relay. Winner of

overall pot shoot gets the pot with the winner announced at the Awards Ceremony.

(3) Lever action pistol caliber shoot will be held Friday, June 20 starting 1 pm. Five shots offhand at 100 yds. and 5 shots using cross sticks for 200 yd. shoot. Location: 300 yd. range. If a pot shoot, cost is \$1 per person per relay. Winner of overall pot shoot gets the pot with the winner announced at the Awards Ceremony.

(4) Mono-on-Mono: This will be a shooter-against-shooter match. Held Saturday afternoon by Stage 6 some time after main match. Location: 100 yd. range. If a pot shoot it will cost 25¢ per person per relay, winner gets the pot.

**Buckaroos:** If a buckaroo has shot in an annual match before, they may enter this Cowboy Action Fun Shoot and pay an entry fee of \$15. If they have not, a timed shoot for Buckaroos (ages 13 and under) will be held on Saturday some time after the main match at Stage 1. No cost. A parent will need to be with the shooter and a Range Officer will be on hand. Location: 100 yd. range. Award: ribbon for places 1-3.

**Wash-up Station:** This will be provided under the overhang on the east end of the Clubhouse.

**Lunch:** We are trying to get a lunch wagon at the range for Saturday and Sunday but will not have a confirmation on this for a couple of months. We will get more information out on this when we receive it. If this is not available, no food will be provided at the Fun Shoot except for the following: .

**Potluck dinner, Saturday @ 6 pm.**

If you plan on attending the potluck, those with their real last name beginning with

--**A** through **I** are asked to bring 1 salad,

--**J** through **Q** are asked to bring 1 meat,

--**R** thru **Z** are asked to bring 1 dessert.

--and we have someone providing home-made biscuits!!

You will need to bring your own table service, chair, and a table/tv tray, if you want one.
