



We're the Orygun Gunfighters, some of us anyway. And we're providing two-days of side matches for you and your friends at this weekend's cowboy action match. We hope you'll drop by and get to know us, and try a hand at what we do.

Formed in 2007 and sanctioned by the Cowboy Fast Draw Association (CFDA) in 2008, we shoot CFDA-style *fast draw* matches the first and third Saturdays of every month at the L Bar T Bison Ranch in Forest Grove, Oregon. During the cold and wet winter months, we shoot indoors at Ted Blocker Holsters in Tigard, Oregon.

If you shoot with us this weekend, you'll discover that cowboy fast draw is shot with real .45 caliber single action guns. No "race guns" are allowed and shotgun primers alone propel the wax bullets down range at speeds approaching 800 feet per second. Guns are drawn from the strong side only, from "period correct" holsters. Most shooters affix a rawhide or metal shield to the bottom of their holsters for safety. Some people "fan" their guns. But most people "thumb" their six-shooters, cocking the hammer and firing at speeds just over 3/10s of a second! Many of us shoot more slowly, appreciating the challenge and warmth of great costumes and good friends.



Is cowboy fast draw for you? We hope so. And to introduce you to the sport, we're offering you 10 shots for \$5. You can split them between friends—you'll get spiffy winner / loser certificates in return—or compete alone for the weekend's "Top Gun" award, given to the shooter who achieves the fastest shot.
